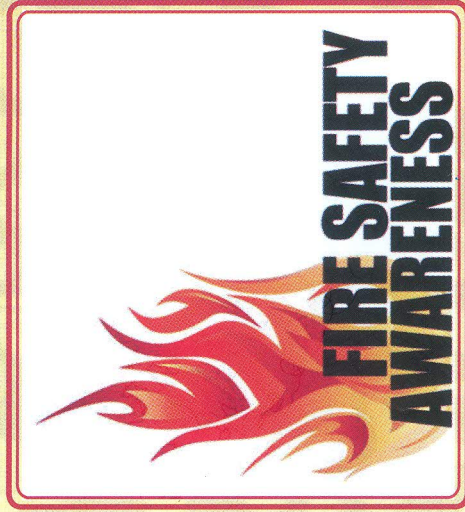

PERSPECTIVE

The risk of damage due to fire depends on the combustible available, their physical arrangement, the geometry of building, likelihood of ignition, etc. The risk is also controlled by fire protection measures in place, which relate to both fire prevention & fire control. 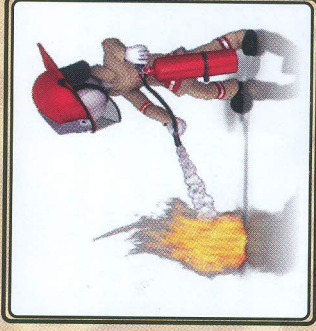

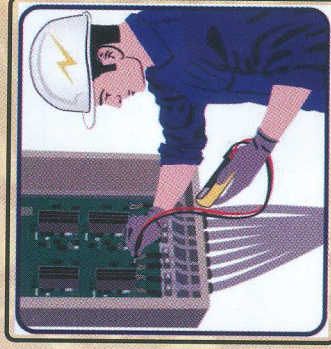

PERSPECTIVE

Every installation has some fire hazard and risk related to fire. The fire hazard is due to presence of flammable or combustible material, along with possibility of spark or ignition. The fire statistics reveals that nearly 8-10% of fatalities are due to fire & explosion in factories / Industries.

NSC is organizing one day Checklist Audit on Fire Safety as a preventive measure against damage & this endeavor is a tribute to the firemen who lost their lives in devastating fire occurred at Bombay Dock in 1944.

As electrical hazard is one of the major cause of fire, NSC has launched this new concept of Electrical Checklist Audit.

This one day Checklist Audit on Fire or Electrical Safety would provide a gap analysis approach for Fire and Electrical Safety Systems & means to improve the safety standard through the major recommendations. These Checklist Audits are arranged for installations at concessional rate only on occasion of Fire Service Week observed all over India.
